### Privacy Policy

Ver. B2B PP 2018-1

**Please be informed that your privacy is important to Skyee. At Skyee, we have a few fundamental principles:**

- We don't ask you for personal information unless we truly need it.
- We don't share your personal information with anyone except to comply with the law, provide our services, or protect our rights.
- We restrict access to your personal information to employees and service providers who need to know that information to provide services to you.
- We maintain physical, electronic and process security protocols to protect your personal information.

Applicable law requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please review this Privacy Policy prior to registering for a Skyee account and providing us with your personal information. If you have any questions about how your data is protected, please don't hesitate to contact Skyee Customer Support.

For the purpose of this Privacy Policy, if you have registered or otherwise use Skyee's services, the term "Skyee" is as defined in the Terms and Conditions of Use; if you are just a visitor to our website, the term "Skyee" refers to Guangzhou Gao Fu Information Technology Co. Ltd.

If there's any conflict between this Privacy Policy and the Terms and Conditions of Use, the Terms and Conditions of Use prevails.

#### **1. Website Visitors**

Like most website operators, Skyee collects non-personally-identifying information of the sort that web browsers and servers typically make available, such as the browser type, language preference, referring site, and the date and time of each visitor request. Skyee's purpose in collecting non-personally identifying information is to better understand how Skyee's visitors use its website. From time to time, Skyee may release non-personally-identifying

information in the aggregate, e.g., by publishing a report on trends in the usage of its website.

Skyee also collects potentially personally identifying information like Internet Protocol (IP) addresses for logged in users. Skyee only discloses logged in user IP addresses under the same circumstances that it uses and discloses personally identifying information as described below.

## **2. Gathering of Personally-Identifying Information**

Certain visitors to Skyee's websites choose to interact with Skyee in ways that require Skyee to gather personally identifying information, including registering for a Skyee account. The amount and type of information that Skyee gathers depends on the nature of the interaction. Those who register for a Skyee account, for example, are asked to provide personally-identifying information, including, as necessary, the personal and financial information required to process any transactions that are executed through us. Visitors can always refuse to supply personally identifying information, with the caveat that it may prevent them from being able to use Skyee's services. We may use your personal information to contact you in order to keep your account up-to-date or in order to notify you of any changes, improvements or promotions related to our product. We may also collect your personal information from others such as credit bureaus, public records, or other companies.

## **3. Protection of Certain Personally-Identifying Information**

Skyee discloses potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only to those of its employees, service providers and affiliated organizations that (i) need to know that information in order to process it or to provide services, and (ii) that have agreed not to disclose it to others. Some of those employees, service providers and affiliated organizations may be located outside of your home country; by using Skyee's websites, you consent to the transfer of such information to them. We may also need to pass your information to government authorities, regulatory bodies, police/law enforcement agencies, or a court of law. This would be done, for example, to meet legal requirements, to aid in the prevention of a crime, or for other lawful purposes.

If you are a registered user of Skyee's website and have supplied your email address, Skyee will notify you by email of any account correspondence. We may also occasionally send you an email to tell you about new features, solicit your feedback, or just keep you up to date with what's going on with Skyee and our products.

Skyee takes all measures reasonably necessary to protect against the unauthorized access, use, alteration or destruction of potentially personally identifying information. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files.

Skyee will not rent or sell potentially personally identifying information to anyone.

We may record our telephone calls with customers for security and training purposes.

#### **4. Cookies**

A cookie is a string of information that a website stores on a visitor's computer, and that the visitor's browser provides to the website each time the visitor returns. Skyee uses cookies to help Skyee identify and track visitors, their usage of Skyee website, and their website access preferences. Skyee visitors who do not wish to have cookies placed on their computers should set their browsers to refuse cookies before using Skyee's websites.

#### **5. Privacy Policy Changes**

Although most changes are likely to be minor, Skyee may change its Privacy Policy from time to time, and in Skyee's sole discretion. Skyee encourages visitors to frequently check this page for any changes to its Privacy Policy. Your continued use of this site after any change in this Privacy Policy will constitute your acceptance of such change.
